Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disorganized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty, particularly to William I German Emperor of whom at this time I am a subject, and to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, since the 10 day of August, anno Domini 1890, and in the State of Wisconsin, continuously next to the 10 day of August, anno Domini 1890, being a residence within this State of at least one year next to the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the Green Bay Court of Green Bay, on the 10 day of Aug, anno Domini 1890, and the cause of such denial has since been renewed.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted to citizenship under the provisions of the act of Congress approved June 25-1910.
