OATH OF ALLEGIANCE

I hereby declare, on oath, that I absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, sovereign, or sovereignty, and particularly to William the II of German Emperor and King of Prussia, an independent state within the bounds of the former German Empire from which I have heretofore been a subject; that I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America, foreign and domestic; and that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same.

NOTE.—In renunciation of title of nobility, add the following to the oath of allegiance before it is executed: "I further renounce the title of (give title), an order of nobility, which I have heretofore borne."
